





## **Oral Auction**

The auctioneer and his assistants determine the successful bidder for every item sold in the oral auction. To bid during the oral auction, hold your bid card high until the auctioneer acknowledges your bid.

## **End of Evening Raffle**

Tickets for the raffle will be sold during the silent auction. The winner will be picked at 10:00 p.m. at the end of the oral auction. Winner does not need to be present to win.

## **Payment and Item Removal**

Before going to the cashier, obtain a computerized list of your successful bids and other purchases made during the evening. With printouts in hand, proceed to the cashier for payment.

Payment by cash, personal check, Visa, or MasterCard is accepted only. We are unable to process any payments using Discover Card or American Express. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. Payment must be made in full on the night of the Auction.



Upon receiving your paid receipt, go to item pickup where a volunteer will greet you. Our volunteer will borrow your receipt and retrieve your purchases for you.
