





Registration

Oral Auction

The auctioneer and his assistants determine the successful bidder for every item sold in the oral auction. To bid during the oral auction, hold your bid card high until the auctioneer acknowledges your bid.

End of Evening Raffle

Tickets for the raffle will be sold during the silent auction. The winner will be picked at 10:00 p.m. at the end of the oral auction. Winner does not need to be present to win.

Payment and Item Removal

Before going to the cashier, obtain a computerized list of your successful bids and other purchases made during the evening. With printouts in hand, proceed to the cashier for payment.

Payment by cash, personal check, Visa, or MasterCard is accepted only. We are unable to process any payments using Discover Card or American Express. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. Payment must be made in full on the night of the Auction.

Upon receiving your paid receipt, go to item pickup where a volunteer will greet you. Our volunteer will borrow your receipt and retrieve you purchases for you. Please do not go directly to the display tables to retrieve you purchases. A PAID receipt is

required before any item may be taken from the auction site.

For security reasons, all auction purchases must be moved from the premises immediately following the event. Exceptions can be made for items too large to remove on auction night. In this case, purchasers may make arrangements by calling the auction office at 503-245-5062. Messages will be returned after March 12, 2012. Please pick up all items no later than March 21st from 8 a.m. - 9 a.m. or 2:30 - 3:15 p.m, Monday-Friday. Bring your paid receipt when picking up items.




